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SID: Ancient rabbis tell us that when the shofar is played all the promises of the Jewish prophets are released. The molecular structure of the atmosphere is literally changed. I tell you miracles will be released.

*Is there a supernatural dimension, a world beyond the one we know? Is there life after death? Do angels exist? Can our dreams contain messages from Heaven? Can we tap into ancient secrets of the supernatural? Are healing miracles real? Sid Roth has spent over 35 years researching the strange world of the supernatural. Join Sid for this edition of **It's Supernatural**.*

SID: Hello, Sid Roth here. Welcome to my world where it's naturally supernatural. And wow. **When you hear Don Heist play the shofar something supernatural is going to happen in your life.** You get ready, because the last time he was on *It's Supernatural*, we had so many reports of people that were, in fact, I just heard someone's neck was just healed and someone's back was just healed just as I was speaking. Don, there is an anointing, a presence of God for healing on this show. For those that don't know much about the shofar, explain it to me.

DON: Well the shofar is an antelope horn off the kudu antelope from northeast Africa in Yemen. And it's used to sound the voice of God. We believe that it is the sound of the voice of God. It was first introduced in the scriptures in the Book of Genesis, Chapter 22, where Abraham and Isaac were climbing Mount Moriah and there was a ram caught in a thicket. And that was the beginning of where we heard talks of rams' horns and shofars in the Bible.

SID: Well you know, the ancient rabbis say that when the shofar is blown it's as if all of the promises of God in the scriptures are transmitted into the atmosphere, and when these promises go forth you have to change. Don, tell me the types of healings you're getting from playing the shofar.

DON: We've seen people healed of cancer, blindness has been, sight has been restored, deafness has been removed, various different kinds of back injuries.

SID: Speaking of back injuries, tell me about one.

DON: I was at a home group, prayer group one night giving a teaching on the shofar and a lady that was there in attendance had showed me that her back was very curved and it had been like that many years, I suppose, and she asked if we would pray for her. So we laid hands on her, prayed for her, and as I sounded the shofar, raising the horn up her back, I could see the curve in her back was just disappearing, and it was gone.

SID: That has to be so overwhelming for her. But it's got to be overwhelming you to see something like that.

DON: Well I've been saying a lot lately, it doesn't surprise me, but it still amazes me.

SID: Now you make a proclamation, this is a cancer-free zone. Tell me the last person that was healed of cancer.

DON: We were contacted by a Navy retired officer and he had been diagnosed with stage four prostate cancer. And he had contacted us, and my wife and I went to his home. We prayed over him, sounded the shofar, and prayed some more and sounded some more, and he left in a day or so for Cancer Centers of America where he was treated. When he got there he asked them to retest him because he felt God had touched him and changed everything. And they said, well, if you want to go through all that testing, sure. So they put him through all the testing again and when they came back, they said, 'It's gone.' There was just a slight little bit that they gave him one treatment for, maybe two. I'm not sure exactly. But otherwise, God had totally removed the cancer from his body just by sounding the voice of God into it.

SID: Okay. Tell me about the person with the lumps in their chest.

DON: I was at a conference in Florida a number of years ago, a few years ago and this man was diagnosed with golf ball sized lumps in his lungs, of cancer. And what happened was, again, we prayed and blew the shofar. Only I was totally unaware of what was going on at this point. I sounded the shofar and he kept being curious saying, "What's that one sound like? What's that one sound like?" So I kept playing them. And then about two weeks later I get an email from this gentleman that says, "Just want to tell you what that was all about." And he said he had been back to the hospital, retested, and they actually sent him to another hospital to be retested again because the lumps of cancer were gone, and they actually thought the machine malfunctioned and didn't show it.

SID: Now there was specific time that you were prophesied over, and since that point the miracles have erupted. Tell me about that moment.

DON: I was in a conference in southern Florida and Bob Griffin was a speaker there, and he was walking across in front of the platform where I was playing as part of the worship team. And as he walked across he just stopped and looked me square in the eye, points his finger at me, and he really had my attention at that point. And so he says, "I've got a word for you from God." And I'm thinking, 'oh no.' This could be good or this could be bad. So he says, "God just told me to tell you whenever you blow, the cancer must go."

SID: And since that point you've seen this.

DON: Since that point, little by little, more and more miracles have been taking place and I give the power of God and Jesus all the credit to this because obviously the only way these miracles can happen is by his voice speaking into people and healing them.

SID: Now you make a distinction between blowing the shofar and playing the shofar. What do you mean?

DON: Well a lot of times when I'm playing the shofar I try to use, I travel with six of them. Let me say that. And they're cut and formulated into different keys. And by that I can match the pitch or the key signature that a worship team is playing in and I accentuate the music with that.

SID: To me, you play it just like a musical instrument.

DON: I try to play it like that.

SID: I have never heard anyone play the shofar the way you play it.

DON: Thank you, Sid. But it's truly a gift from God.

SID: I believe it is and you're about ready to experience this gift from God. Don't go away. We'll be right back.

SID: Hello, Sid Roth here with Don and Sue Heist. And Don will shortly play the shofar and the atmosphere in your home is going to change. Speaking of atmosphere in your home, you know, when I go into a hotel or a motel room, I want to clean out that atmosphere. There is nothing that will clean out that atmosphere better than playing the shofar. So I take a CD and I play the shofar, and it is so peaceful. It's as peaceful as this set is, right here. Now Sue, you pray for your husband. You hear all the reports of your husband playing the shofar and miracles are breaking out. But 18 years ago you were rear-ended and you had quite physical ailments after that. Tell me about it.

SUE: Well we were in an auto accident and through that pain started coming and they got to a position where they were just so excruciating that they finally found, through a lost of testing, that I had a Arnold-Chiari malformation at the base of my brain.

SID: What does that mean?

SUE: It's the base of the brain is a tonsil that is like a point that lies low out of the skull. And what it basically meant for me is that whenever I would bend over I would have severe knife stabbing pain in the top of my head. The symptoms are vertigo. It prevents you from seeing a lot of movement, being in any movement. I couldn't ride comfortably in a car. I could drive because you can anticipate the motion. I didn't do elevators or escalators or I couldn't fly in an airplane.

SID: What would happen if you did an escalator?

SUE: I would have a severe pain at the top of my head. Sometimes it would last a few minutes. Sometimes it would last a few days. I think the biggest hindrance for me, as a mother, was to not be able to do things with my children. I remember my daughter coming to me and just almost in tears saying, "Mommy, don't you feel good enough just to play one game with us?" And I had so much pain that there's things I wanted to do, to chaperone field trips or do something with the children that I couldn't do. I just had so much pain.

SID: Okay, obviously you prayed to be healed. You believed in praying.

SUE: I did.

SID: Your husband, you're releasing him to go over the world to play the shofar so miracles could happen for other people. When did you come to your senses that maybe, just maybe he could play that shofar over you and you could get healed?

SUE: God love him. Don prayed for me for the 18 and a half years, but the one time before he went for a conference I always say that this righteous anger in me was just like I wanted him to pray one more time and blow the shofar right in the back of my head before he left. And it wasn't so much that I was angry of what was happening. Maybe I was jealous that when he blew the shofar at these conferences and people were healed, it was the power and presence of God that changed lives and so much that was happening that just wasn't happening with me or with our family. And I wanted a piece of that. And God took me to the scripture with Moses when he went on Mount Sinai and met with God and God said, "Go down and consecrate the people for three days and I will come." And God blew the shofar. He blew the trumpet of God and spoke to Moses, and the people feared and trembled because of the power and presence of God. And it's like, I saw that happening where Don went to conferences that people, their lives were being changed and they were being drawn into that presence, and I wanted more of that. And when he left for this conference, before he left, I said, "Please pray one more time and I want you to blow the shofar right in the back of my head." And he was a little reluctant because of the sound being so loud. I said, "I don't care this time. I want you to blow the shofar before you leave." And he did. He was obedient to do it.

SID: You're just like my wife. When she hears the shofar she'll step away because it gets so loud.

SUE: I was persistent.

SID: But you didn't care because you were desperate.

SUE: I had been to a lot of altar calls and a lot of prayers, and it was just like that particular time I just released my heart to God and said, ‘okay, if this is it, Lord, you're going to heal me this time. Wonderful. And if not, I'm going to continue to praise and worship you.’ And Don blew the shofar and he left the conference. And the next day I remember dropping something on the floor, and without even thinking, I bent over to pick it up and it startled me. I was like, wait a minute. That didn't hurt. I didn't have any pain. And until he came home three days later, I was totally, miraculously healed of every symptom.

SID: Don, you felt like you had a new wife.

DON: Oh I did. I was greeted at the airport by Sue and our son, and you got to remember up to this point, we couldn't ride escalators or elevators together. If we went on steps I would walk in front of her and she would sort of hold onto me because of the vertigo. And we get to the airport and she goes, "Watch this." And she starts going up and down the escalator, and I'm like, what's going on here? You're going to hurt yourself. Don't do this. I was unaware of the miracle that had happened.

SID: Now Sue, you were having some fun there.

SUE: I was. Even our son, when we first got to the airport he wanted to go on the moving walkway and I jumped on it before him and he tried to stop me and he said, "Mommy, what are you doing? You're going to be so sick." And I'm like, ‘no, we're going to do this.’ And he was just like, ‘what's going on here?’ And I told him, I said, "Nathan, I feel God totally and miraculously healed me through the blowing of the shofar and the prayer." Every symptom, to this day, it's over two and half years and every symptom is gone.

SID: Don, creative miracles are happening. For instance, there was someone with a leg three inches shorter, that's pretty long, than the other one. Tell me what happened.

DON: I was at a Sunday evening church service, not even expecting to minister in any way except just the sound of the shofar if I was led of the Holy Spirit to do so. And at the end of the service there was a time of prayer for healing and I was just led to pray with this man. He came in to the service with like a wood block on his one foot, his left foot, because his leg was about three inches shorter than his right leg. And a number of people were there. We laid hands on him and prayed. I sounded the shofar as led by the Holy Spirit. I blew, played the shofar into his leg and as I continued praying I had my hand on his leg, lower leg, and I could actually feel it moving. And when we finished praying with the man, he said, "I feel different." He stood up and his legs were level. And one thing I remember is he left that night in his stocking feet because he couldn't wear the shoe with the lift on it. For the first time, I don't know how long in how many years, he had level feet with level legs.

SID: Now that is proof positive. But in a moment I'm going to have Don play that shofar and whatever your need I believe it's going to manifest in Yeshua's name. Don't go away. Be right back.

SID: Hello, Sid Roth here with Don Heist. In a moment I'm going to ask Don to play the shofar and miracles will erupt. Don, I have to tell you a trade secret. When I was a brand new believer, I got the privilege of meeting a woman by the name of Katherine Kuhlman. She had the greatest miracle ministry I've ever known of. And she prayed over me and I immediately started praying for the sick. I prayed for hundreds of people, literally. And guess how many people got healed? Zero! None! I mean, even my pastor walked up to me one day and he said, "Sid, I feel very uncomfortable over you praying for people." But I persevered, and more important than persevered is I learned. I studied the Word and I found out that there is a difference between a miracle and a healing. A miracle happens instantly, but a healing is gradual. For example, if someone is pregnant the moment they're pregnant they do not realize that the stomach will come out, etc. You can't see that. Well they realize it, but you just can't see it. But they are pregnant with the seed. They are going to have a baby. And if you will hold on to the seed when Don plays the shofar over you and you will be as excited on the day you're pregnant with your healing, as the day the baby comes forth. You see, if you just say, 'I guess it didn't work,' you got an abortion. You don't want an abortion. You want what God promises. And God's promise says that they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. Well I believe the point of contact for you will be the playing of the shofar. I want your faith to soar. You see, over the last 40 years, I have interviewed people from different streams of healing and God is so unique. He's like a perfect diamond. And if there's one way you're approaching healing and it doesn't work; approach it another way. I want to take you to this teaching right now.

You Are Created for Signs and Wonders...message by Sid Roth

SID: How can we work the same miracles that Yeshua worked? Read the book. Amplified Bible, John 6:28: "Then they said," this is the disciples to Yeshua, "What are to do that we may have habitually be working the works of God?" Good question. How would you like to ask Yeshua that question? I want to habitually do what you're doing, Yeshua. How can I do it? Well he answers that question. Yeshua replied in John 6:29, "This is the work that God asks of you, that you believe in the one whom He has sent, that you cleave to trust, rely on and have faith in His messenger." Now if you have faith in His messenger, the way you do is to have faith in His message. What must you do about His message? You must cleave to His message, trust His message, rely on His message and have faith in His message. Now what's His message in reference to healing? Psalm 103, Verse 3 and 5: "God forgives," how many of your iniquities? "All" of your iniquities. Anyone doubt that, that the blood of Yeshua is not strong enough to erase all of our sins? There isn't one person that doubts that. Well this is what he continues to

say. "Who heals his blood. Heals all of your diseases. Incline your ear to my sayings. Faith comes by hearing and hearing the Word of God." Verse 21: "Do not let them depart from your eyes;" continuously!" The "Word" not the symptoms. The Word, don't let them get away from your eyes. Do not let that Word get away. That's the Kingdom. That's the air you should be breathing, the promises of God explaining the Kingdom of Heaven. My will, your will, God, be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Any sickness in Heaven? No. Any sin in Heaven? No. Your kingdom, your will be done on Earth as it is done in Heaven. Find out what's going on Heaven and that's what God has directed to do on Earth. Keep them in the midst of your heart. You see, in your heart is where you believe. You've got to get those promises into your heart. Keep them in the midst of your heart. Don't doubt the Word. Doubt the symptoms legal rights and permission to be there. That's what you should doubt. Keep them in the midst of your heart, for they are life only to those who find them. They are life only if you find them. They're not life if you don't find them. You get it? And health, or the Greek word, the Hebrew word means "medicine" or "medicine to all their flesh." What should the laborers do? Matthew 10:1: "And when he had called his 12 disciples to him he gave them power over unclean spirits to cast them out and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease." Then Verse 7 and 8 of Matthew 10: "And as you go," but you got to go. "As you go," you just kept coming to my Messianic congregation, my church. "As you go, go! As you go, preach, saying, 'The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand and I can prove it to you by healing the sick, cleaning the lepers, raising the dead and casting out demons!'" Those are the words of our Messiah. That is normal. Anything short of that is religious. Mark 16, Verse 17 and 18: "And these signs will follow those who believe." Raise your hand if you believe. Okay, about five of you for salvation because you think I can't see you. No, you're just lazy. All right. It says, "These signs will follow those who believe in my name. In the name of Yeshua, they will cast out demons. They will speak with new tongues. They will lay hands on the sick," and they *might* recover. Oh, some of you aren't sleeping. Good. That's our Messiah saying it, not me. They will lay hands. Who's the "they"? Those who believe. Who believes? Those who just raised their hand. "And they will recover." Let every man be a liar, but God's Word is truth." (Applause)

SID: Are you ready? I tell you, the anointing of healing is going to enter your body. You will either get a miracle or a healing. No abortion. You will get your healing or your miracle. Your point of contact is when Don plays the shofar. Don, would you do that?
