Can our dreams contain messages from Heaven? Can we tap into ancient secrets of the supernatural? Are healing miracles real? Sid Roth has spent over 35 years researching the strange world of the supernatural. Join Sid for this edition of **It's Supernatural**.*

SID: Hello Sid Roth again. Welcome to my world where it's naturally supernatural. There's something new happening on Planet Earth. Muslims in extremely large numbers are having visitations of Jesus. And many are going to Heaven. Many are having dreams and visions. The most phenomenal thing is happening. And when they get mature in God they're not normal American Christians. They move in the most extraordinary signs and wonders, and miracles. And we have two with us that you're going to hear from. By the time you finish hearing the second one, you will not be upset about anything going on in your life. There is a rarified air of Heaven on this program. It makes a difference from anything you've ever seen before. My guest was born in Pakistan. His name is Fasel Malick. Islam was his whole life. Hours everyday he would study the Koran. He came to Canada. He got involved in network marketing. But still Islam was his whole life. He went to one of their meetings. It was a big meeting, 20,000 people, and he was told if he goes to the first meeting he'll be in the front row for the second meeting with these top experts in network marketing. So he says, I'll do it. He didn't know it was a church service. And then he came to his senses. He says, "Oh, I see what they're doing. They're using this network marketing to market Jesus. I'm going to observe what they do and I'll do the same thing for Islam." And so he goes to his third meeting like this and they say stand up to accept Jesus as the Messiah, and he stands up out of respect. And all of a sudden, Fasel, the last thing in the world you expected, what happened?

FAISAL: Well suddenly God showed up. I didn't know this was even possible. I remember standing there and His presence went right through me, went right around me. I was completely surrounded with the presence of God. I had all these questions going through my heart and mind like, what is going on, how is this possible. First of all, I didn't understand why God would manifest amongst the people that I thought were blaspheming by worshiping Jesus. And so this is going through me. And I'm in His presence, and all of these questions are disappearing, except one question that was burning in my heart. And I said, "God, what are you doing here? I thought these were the bad guys," meaning the Christians. And then I heard an audible, and He said, "No, these are my children." And He said it again, "No, these are my children." And a third time, "No, these are my children." And when He said that it was like everything I had experienced as a Muslim, all I had ever known about God immediately was gone, and I was only conscious of one reality, that Jesus, you are the Son of God.

SID: Okay. Let me take you now to February 24th. You experienced the river of God's love. Tell me about that.

FAISAL: I never knew God could actually come in to see an individual. I always thought He showed up in large crowds like that meeting. So here I was at 7:30 in the morning, the tangible presence of God, the reality of God just began to fill that entire basement, the basement I was living in. And it got stronger and stronger, and stronger, and I sensed a tangible river go right

through my being. It was non-stop like a river waterfall, just flowing so powerfully. But it was love, it was life, it was substance. It was something I had never experienced, and it's going right through me non-stop for three hours. And I remember hearing this beautiful audible yet authoritative voice, and this was the voice of our Father, Father God. And He said, "I love you, son, I love you, son, I love you, son," three times.

SID: But you must have known that within Islam.

FAISAL: No. Actually all my life, Sid, I never heard those words growing up as a Muslim. I never remember hearing the words, "I love you." I remember hearing, "I wish you weren't born." I remember hearing things like that. But something in those words, when He said, "I love you, son," that began to do something to me. I didn't even know how to respond except by saying, "I love you, Father, I love you, Father." It was this exchange of supernatural love in the form of a river tangibly. And all I can tell you is three things happened as a result. Number one, I had a love and intense hunger for the Father. I had a love for God I didn't have until that point in my life. Number two, I have more love for people. You know, we are all growing in love. So I suddenly sensed I loved people more than I did at that moment. And the third thing was I had a love and a hunger intensely for the Word of God. And I remember picking up the Bible and for 36 hours supernaturally I read through the entire Bible. I couldn't eat anything. I could only digest the Word of God. And it was supernatural in that when I would look at the page of the Bible literally a page or a passage at a time would almost lift off the page, go inside of my spirit, and I understood what it was saying. I knew exactly what was happening. I didn't know what to call it, but that was revelation, that God began to write His word upon my heart. And I began to have a revelation of God's realities as truth, and began to apply them to my life. That's how it started.

SID: You know what's the most amazing thing to me? Just about everyone he talked to, this river that he had in him of liquid love, started going out of him and touching something like 1500 people.

SID: Hello. Sid Roth here. And I am so excited to be speaking to you. Do you know why? Because I have got two former Muslims that have had such encounters with the Living God. I am so impressed with so many of the people that are from Islam that are having encounters with God. And as fervent as they were for Islam, they're even more fervent once they come to know the love of God. They believed in God within Islam, but they never knew the love of God. Fasel, tell me about Kamal.

FAISAL: At the age of five he was already dreaming about killing infidels, Israelites and Americans. At the age of seven he joined the PLO and they taught him how to use an AK47, and he started his terrorist career. And he started training children and taking them into the Golan Heights in Israel, smuggling ammunition, TNT and bombs and explosives to have bomb threats and killings to go on. That's what he was doing at that young age, and that was his passion. That's how he grew up. And it's absolutely amazing through the journey how God really touched him.

SID: But he was involved in a horrible automobile accident. And a doctor felt sorry for him because he was now in America. He came to America to win as many people to Islam as possible. And by the way, I found it interesting. They use women to win.

FAISAL: Kamal explained how he was trying to commit what they call cultural Jihad. So they come to America and they find women to marry so they can their citizenship or resident cards, whatever they needed and they would spread Islam through their families. And this is the kind of journey he was on. He would also visit the poor. He's also meet African-Americans. These are all part of their strategies through which they felt to spread Islam. And then he had this accident that you referred to and it was absolutely—

SID: This doctor took a liking to him. The guy is there, really he hates everyone. But they took a liking to him. They took him into their home with their children. And the children, he couldn't handle it. The children loved him. They love bombed him. Let's go to him speaking in his own words.

Kamal: And now these little kids put their little hand on me. I'm sorry, I'm doing the Jesus prayer. I was trained to fight anything in life, to take down any big giant. But those little loving kids that played, touched my hand, melted my heart. There is a war inside of me. These men that come once a week will make a hole, will make a circle around me, and they put me in the middle and they prayed that God may bless me, that God, may a light shine His face upon me, that God can bless me. And they're doing this in the name of Jesus. Now I came to this understanding that these people are not the bad people that I thought that they are. Allah, these people have a relationship with their God. I want to have a relationship with you, too. I want to hear you say that you love me. I want to know you. If you are real speak to me. Now bear in mind, these men and women, they pray for healing and receive it. They pray for breakthrough, they receive breakthrough. They pray, they ask and I hear them saying, "I heard God say this and this." I'm going, I want to have that relationship. If this is real I want to have it because I've been worshiping Allah all the days of my life and I've earned it.

SID: You know, Kamal got so frustrated because his God wouldn't love him like these Christians had the love. His God wouldn't even speak to him. Nothing. So he got so desperate he decides to commit suicide. What happened next?

FAISAL: Well he pulls out his gun and he's getting to shoot himself, and he hears this voice, and the voice says very gently, "Kamal, Muslims worship the God of Abraham and pray to him, Jews pray to the God of Abraham and Christians pray to the God of Abraham. Why don't you pray and call on the God of Abraham, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." So he said, okay,

let me give this a try. So he says, "O God of Abraham, if you are real, show yourself. Reveal yourself to me." And suddenly this light began to fill his room, this glory he says came into the room and Jesus walked right into the room. And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" kind of like Paul said. And he heard Jesus say to him, "I am that I am." And he says, "What is that supposed to mean?" He says, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end." And that is where he got so touched by Jesus. He got instantly healed, his neck, his collar bone, his bones, instantly.

SID: He was so severe that he couldn't function himself.

FAISAL: He could not. But instantly he was healed and he felt this liquid fire and love go through him and he was supernaturally healed at that very moment.

SID: Okay. Before you came on the set you told me God spoke to you today. What did He say?

FAISAL: Sid, there's been so much hatred demonstrated to the Jewish people from my brothers and my sisters, the Muslim people, all over the world. And there's been dishonor towards the Jews and hatred. And I really felt to ask you because you are Jewish, and you know and love the Messiah, I feel God asked me to ask you if you would forgive my brothers and sisters, my people for the atrocities, the dishonor and the hatred that has been shown to the Jewish people. And God spoke to me and said, if you do this that millions of Muslims will experience salvation all over the world, and so many Jews will experience and know who the Messiah is, because God's heart is the Jew and gentile, Jew and Muslim, through the cross become one new man and experience him in one body. And I really believe that something significant is suppose to happen here. And I believe I'm supposed to ask you. So I want to ask you, would you forgive us for what we have done.

SID: I have to tell you something. I have done some pretty despicable things myself, and God has forgiven me. And who am I to not offer forgiveness because of what God has done to me. And I totally forgive you for everything you've ever done to any Jewish person, everything you've ever said against my nation, Israel. I totally forgive you because of the blood of Yeshua, who has forgiven me and because that blood of Yeshua is available to you right now. We'll be right back with one of the most amazing Muslims I have ever met in my life.

SID: Hello. Sid Roth here with Kalida [name]. Now Kalida is a Palestinian Arab. And I have never heard, I don't know how you survived, Kalida. I mean, and you have a smile on your face. But let me tell you a little about Kalida. When she was 11 days old her mother died, her father

abandoned her and she was put into an orphanage. And she stayed in this orphanage until age nine. She went out to get some water to drink and a bomb hits the orphanage, and her new family wiped out. And then somehow they didn't know what to do with her. And you're just nine years old and they sell you as a slave to Bedouins. You were worse than a slave. They would beat you. The only food you had was leftovers. And the soldiers finally rescued you and they put you in another orphanage. And then they found your natural father, but he didn't want you. I mean, rejection, rejection. How much rejection can a human take? I don't know how a human can have that much rejection. And then your father makes you a slave. He doesn't want you. And at age 15 he forces her into a marriage. The husband after a while and after a child kicks her out, divorces her, horrible shame. Her father still wants to get rid of her. So he gets rid of your only child and he marries you off again to a man. You go to the United States and this man, I mean, according to my notes here, he broke your jaw. Why did he do that?

KHALIDA: Well he was an angry man, and he was my husband. And in Islam they teach men that they need to correct their wives. So he had just given me a good lesson and he was very good to break my jaw. I didn't learn anything, by the way.

SID: I'm sure. Okay. You have three children. You're married to an abusive husband. I don't get it. How could you take all of this? Not just him. Your whole life, how did you do it?

KHALIDA: Well I was going crazy, but the grace of God.

SID: Then it gets worse. He lets her know he's going to kill her. What did you do about that?

KHALIDA: I needed to run away. I needed to run for my life. I was afraid.

SID: You actually heard a voice.

KHALIDA: I heard a voice. I remember, like I told you, trying to kill myself before I heard that voice. And then I heard an audible voice saying to me, "Leave the darkness into the light." Now I thought I'm going crazy anyway, but might as well, I'll follow that voice. I'm not going to lose anything.

SID: Okay. But what does a woman do that doesn't speak English, doesn't have money and has three small children wandering the streets? What happened to you?

KHALIDA: I met a Christian lady that took me in as her own daughter and told me about the love of Jesus.

SID: But you loved Islam. You really did love Islam.

KHALIDA: I did.

SID: So you love this woman for what she did for you, but you didn't want her Jesus.

KHALIDA: Exactly. And my conflict was always, how can I believe that God has a son, because they taught us in Islam that God cannot be weak and have a son. That's a sign of weakness. So I struggled with that. I wanted to have the love that woman had, and that was the breaking point. I saw her joy. I saw her love. I saw her life being simple, but she was always connecting to God, and I was hungry for that.

SID: And then you decide, this is the moment I want to know the truth. Tell me what your prayer was and what happened.

KHALIDA: I remembered feeling sick and tired being sick and tired. And I remember praying, asking Jesus, if you really who you are, what people say you are, because I didn't know if this is true or not, really. If people say that you are the Son of God then show me, then come to me and show me that you are the Son of God. And I didn't think anything was going to happen out of that prayer. But the result of that simple prayer was Jesus appearing to me and have an encounter with the Lord in the supernatural.

SID: That would have been enough. But then she goes on to Heaven. What did you see in Heaven?

KHALIDA: I saw worship. I saw how much Heaven adores Jesus as the Son of God, exalted as a king. Some of the things I saw that, babies, people, beings were throwing a crown at the feet of Jesus. He was strong and majestic.

SID: You didn't know this was in the Bible.

KHALIDA: I didn't know. I never read the Bible before I had that experience. All I knew is what I'm seeing has to be real because it was so vivid and it was so real, and I became part of Heaven. There is no way you can deny it. One thing in Heaven is Jesus is the Word of God, and as you look upon his face and his light, and his glory, revelation becomes so vivid and so real. You cannot escape it. You just cannot run from it.

SID: You know what's exciting to me is she now prays for people and they miracles. People with cancer get healed. But what is more exciting to me is some of the revelations she learned about worship. And she's a worshiper of God like you've never seen before, like you're going to see because you are going to become a worshiper of God. I am going to ask Kalida to worship God the way you do in your home, when no one is there but God. And some of you in the audience and some of you in the audience at home, I want you to worship God. And if you'll do this God is going to show up. Would you worship God right now.

KHALIDA: Yes. I want to look people right in the face and tell them that there is power in speaking in your heavenly language. There is power. The Bible calls it perfect grace to God. You cannot go wrong. The fact that we are created to worship Him when we enter into that with faith then He must show up. And the Bible says He will inhabit his praises.

SID: Right now just as if you're in your home.

KHALIDA: [speaking in tongues]. And when I speak it in English, what I was saying, what I was sensing in my spirit is exalting Jesus above everything, above your circumstances, above your divorce your struggle, above your sickness, above your disease, above everything that you're dealing with. Even on a daily basis you exalt that king above all of your circumstances, and I guarantee you, you will have experience like Hagar had with God, many people in the Bible like us Muslims. As we exalt Jesus we become a true worshiper of God. We truly submit to the Spirit of God because that is our weapon of welfare. No way you can lose ever a battle for God if you worship Him in spirit and in truth.

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SID: Next week on *It's Supernatural*. My guest should have been a basket case. She had such trauma in her life that what you had is nothing compared to what she went through. And supernaturally she was taught how to get the clutter out of her.

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
