Hello. Sid Roth here. Welcome to my world, where it's naturally supernatural. In the midst of a Passover celebration by Messianic Jewish recording artist Paul Wilbur, Pastor Stovall with a 15,000-member church had an open vision where he was transported to a heavenly Passover Seder with Jesus and His disciples. What he experienced through this heavenly encounter brought resurrection glory into his church, causing an eruption of miracles. The glory has now spread into the homes of his congregants. Do you want him to pray for this resurrection glory to come on you?

Is there a supernatural dimension? A world beyond the one we know? Is there life after death? Are there hidden forces of darkness trying to block God's blessings for your life? Do angels exist, providing us with supernatural protection, disarming our enemies? Can our dreams contain messages from Heaven? Can we tap into ancient secrets of the supernatural? Is God ready to bring a tsunami wave of healing onto planet Earth today? Sid Roth has spent over 40 years researching the strange world of the supernatural. Join Sid for this edition of **It's Supernatural!**

SID: I have a longtime friend, Paul Wilbur, that most of you are familiar with, and my new friend, Pastor Stovall Weems. Stovall, about, what was it, three months before Paul gave a special presentation on Passover, and I think it was also Good Friday, at your church three months before—what did God tell you?

STOVALL: We had a prophetic word for the year that God was going to restore in three months what had been held up for three years. That was kind of the prophetic word that we had for our church as we entered into a season of prayer and fasting in January.

SID: Paul, you invited Pastor Weems to come up and you handed him a piece of matzo. What did you observe?

PAUL: First of all, it was such a privilege to be asked to speak on that platform. Because it was Good Friday and the first night of Passover, the obvious message is, "We're going to celebrate communion tonight, but I'm going to show you where it came from and how Jesus institutes the new covenant." I determined that at the point where we come to the piece of bread and the third cup, the cup of redemption, that I would call Pastor Stovall to come forward and help me serve the people now that we understood what we were doing in a better way. Either I handed his piece to Pastor Stovall or he took it from the table, and as I began to speak the Hebrew blessing over it, "Blessed are you, O Lord, our God, King of the Universe who brings forth bread from the Earth"-

SID: Chant that just for a second.

PAUL: (chanting in Hebrew) As I did that, something very unexpected happened.

SID: You pick it up from there.

STOVALL: Paul, he would read the Scripture, and when he was reading the part about the bread in Hebrew, right after the first word or even within the first word I head another Hebrew

voice. It was like a voice going from mono to stereo. It was loud, alive, surround sound. That's when I was like, "That's another voice." I'm trying to process what's going on here.

SID: Paul, you just recorded a brand new CD out of Israel. I'm going to tell you, Paul, you outdid yourself. God was with you on that project. It's called "Roar from Zion." Would you go to the music set? I want you to sing the theme song, "Roar from Zion."

PAUL: Sure, happy to.

SID: Pastor, this is quite an unusual situation that happened to you. Have you ever had anything close to that before?

STOVALL: No, no, nothing like that. I mean, I've had experiences in the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit was heavy in that service. To be honest, I wasn't really in a spiritual mood. I was kind of tired. But when I heard that Hebrew voice, and as I'm processing that voice, "What is that? That's not Paul's voice," that's when—The best way I like to describe it is I felt the personality of Jesus, not just the presence of the Holy Spirit was His, it was His personality. I knew it. Jesus is here. This is Jesus. Jesus is here. I looked to the left. I was kind of afraid to look in one sense, but I looked to the left and then that's when I saw the Lord. He was standing on the platform. You know, you don't have a schema. You don't have a place to—

SID: You never walked that road before and no one else, maybe. Well, yeah, Paul said, "I don't know if I was in the body or out of the body." [inaudible 00:06:37] had an experience. Where were you?

STOVALL: Well, at that point, I'm on the stage trying to put, "Is this really happening? Is that Jesus?" That's when, it's like the best I like to say it is, the heavens were opened. They were opened. It was like a veil. It was like I was in the heavenlies. But it was an entirely different setting. I'm saying these things because now I've had, you know, 10 months to process them out with Hebrew scholars and describe where I was and go to the Scriptures and read Hebrews 12. I'm saying these things now with a lot of processing and a whole lot of scholarship and all that kind of stuff. Where I now believe that I was is right there in Hebrews 12. I was in the heavenly Zion and the church of the firstborn, the heavenly host, it was the Lord Jesus Himself as the high priest and He was ministering. There was the table and He was ministering to the heavenly congregation.

SID: He used to love to teach on covenant before this experience, but after his heavenly visitation, communion has gone to a whole new level. That's where the miracles break out. Get your communion elements ready at home for later in the program. Now here's Paul with music from his brand new album, "Roar from Zion."

PAUL: "I will thunder from Jerusalem," say the Lord, "and I will roar from Zion." Hallelujah. Lion of Judah, roar. (singing)

We'll be right back to It's Supernatural. [music]

SID: Pastor Stovall, you had this encounter where you're hearing a voice. It's Jesus saying the prayer. Take me from there.

STOVALL: You know, I saw Him there on the stage and then I like to say that the heavens were opened. They were just open and I was in the heavenly realm with Him. I've walked with God for 29 years now and it's like I had known Him all along, but there were some things that were very new. Next to the Lord, the first thing was the overwhelming—It was fear, but it was pure fear. It didn't have any condemnation, yet at the same time there was this overwhelming love. I couldn't have been more accepted. I couldn't have been more one. I couldn't have been more known. Then there was His personality.

STOVALL: That's the word I like, His personality. He's a man of action. He was strong. His strength just emanates. I felt like I could headbutt a nuclear bomb. When you're with Jesus, I've always related to the Lord as I'm His servant and I am, He's God, I'm the servant, but beyond all words or experience with—this is how Jesus treated me, how I felt. That was the entire kingdom. I saw the kingdom, He showed me His covenant, I beheld His glory, and the overwhelming—He treats you as an equal. He's God, He's the Savior-

SID: I get it.

STOVALL: —but He treats you like an equal, which is beyond ... There's just no words. Then, you know, I could talk about this for hours but the other thing was in His presence, everyone has their place. I had my place. When you're next to Jesus, you have to bow. The weight, you would never just look up and look around. That would be so disrespectful. You're just so glad to have your place. That was my place, at least for that gathering. That was my place. It was like everything was here. He never looked at me and said, "Welcome." I couldn't have been any more welcome or known.

STOVALL: It was like I was one and this is my place, and now the best word that I have to describe how I felt, I felt grafted. I was grafted. I was positioned. It was like I was totally one, but I was different. That was a huge component of the mission. By the way, before this night, Sid, I was like a Gentile of Gentiles. I didn't know Jewish roots. I didn't know the feast. I mean, I was always pro-Israel, bless Israel, but I wasn't this big Jewish roots guy. Honestly, I didn't think any of that mattered.

SID: Are you saying to me, though, this was a table and the apostles were there and Jesus was there and this was a Passover Seder?

STOVALL: I remember my first thought was, before things became clear, "I'm back at the Last Supper." It felt like the Last Supper. But when things became clear I'm like, "Well, this isn't a dark room. This is heavenly." Now the word says, "Do this in

remembrance of me," the remembrance up there is like a total reliving. It's the most visceral remembrance. There's not a human word.

SID: Just so I understand this, Paul hands the matzo to you. You have this encounter. Did you still have the matzo in your hand in Heaven?

STOVALL: Yeah. All of this is going on and a lot more, and like I'm saying, Jesus is just everything. It just takes a while to talk about anything besides Him and putting things together. But the most personal, where it got very, very personal, everything was kingdom, all that's happening, but then all of a sudden it was like it was—I know where I was, but it's like it was just me and the Lord. I was looking at that bread and I knew that the Lord had served me that bread. It was like He was waiting on me. I knew if I ate that bread, I was telling the Lord that He could go die for my sins.

SID: I want to make sure that you got what He just said. Of course the Lord died for everyone's sins, but what I'm hearing you say is He died for your sins, that revelation, isn't it?

STOVALL: Yes. I know, mentally, He's already died for our sins, but in this encounter, it's like He has but He hasn't done it yet. It's like you're going back and then you realize the King, you just realized the Creator of the universe, this being, how He could love you like this? Then He's, you know, He's going to go die for you. He's going to die for you. I knew if I ate that bread, it was the deepest kind of love, loyalty, bond, covenant, family. It was the deepest kind of bond. It was the deepest.

STOVALL: I knew if I took that bread, I knew I was telling him, "Okay, you can go die for my sins now. But in return, I'm going to lay down my life. I'm going to lay down my life for you and I'm going to allow you to live your life through me so we can carry out the Father's mission." It's about the mission, about the Father regathering His kids. It honestly took me a long time. I didn't know about the heavenly pattern. I didn't know about the calendar. I mean, I knew there were Scriptures in the Bible.

SID: Most people look at the biblical feasts as almost entertainment. You're telling me it opened up everything to you.

STOVALL: Yes.

SID: You took almost a year to process what had occurred before he felt ready to really release this. Are you ready for restoration, for healing, for miracles for you and your family? It's actually happening in the homes of Pastor Stovall's members, and he knows it will happen for you, too. More with Pastor Stovall in a moment, but first here is Paul.

PAUL: (singing)

SID: I don't know about you, but I have been feeling the presence of God, the manifest presence of His glory, on this whole show. Pastor Stovall, you talk about terms like "power in the pattern" and "now you're in alignment." Explain a little bit about that.

STOVALL: It was a very humbling experience in the sense I realized that I had been a ruler in a lot of areas instead of being a steward. But through all this process, I felt like I was given Jesus' church back. My mindset changed to, "Okay, I'm a steward, Lord. I saw the kingdom." There were just so many things. It's things like I begin to look through a kingdom filter. Now, obviously, it's Friday, which is the Sabbath. It was Friday night. It was also Passover, so it's the double Sabbath. But then it's almost like I had this kingdom filter. Then I begin to see, "Well, wait, Sabbath was way before the Abrahamic covenant. It's back here in Genesis 2. The Sabbath was the first day after Creation. There's all of God's family, Heaven and Earth, at the Father's table in Eden." Eden was the Bet Av, the Father's house.

STOVALL: Here's the heavenly and earthly family together at His table. That whole language of Shabbat Shalom, this is what it's all about. This is how everything should be. This is wholeness. Yes, you're going to subdue the Earth and all that, but nothing is more important than this. I would say I saw this kingdom where the Jewish people have carried them in the context of covenant. But I began to see these things like, "Wait, these are kingdom. I'm not authorized as a steward of the ministry to substitute things that are clearly a kingdom pattern. I'm just not authorized to do that."

SID: You know, every time you open your mouth, you are unpacking revelation that has been hidden from the church for 2000 years, but let me remind you to get your communion elements ready. In our ISN segment as we take communion together, we will align ourselves with Heaven and Heaven will invade our studio or wherever you're watching us. We'll also have more from Paul Wilbur, so stay with us.
