SID: Now, Laurie Ditto, you're up, you're happy but in the year 2000 you were at rock bottom. How bad was it?

LAURIE: I was so depressed. I had planned my suicide different times. My life just didn't feel ... I had hurt and pain rejection inside of me and I didn't know what to do with it. The only acceptable answer was just to try and find a way to end the pain.

SID: And then you get a flyer in the mail about a conference in another state, and IHOP Conference. Why in the world did you go there?

LAURIE: I held on to that postcard. It's as if it had a sense in it to draw me there. I think someone had prayed over it before it got mailed to my house, and I just knew that I had to go there and it changed my life.

SID: You get there, you're in the prayer room, what happened to you?

LAURIE: When I got there, I didn't know what to expect. People worship God in different ways. I heard the voice of God, he asked me, "What do you want?" I wanted to know if speaking in tongues was real. So, then I got it. I love speaking in tongues.

SID: At the conference you started speaking?

LAURIE: In the prayer room.

SID: Did someone pray for you to?

LAURIE: No, I just asked the Lord, I want to know if it's real.

SID: But not only did you speak in tongues, you got something more. What happened next?

LAURIE: When I came back to the prayer room just in a few hours because I'd left and came back. I wanted to ask God for something else. I had a list of three things I was going to ask Him for. I wanted a log cabin on Lake Superior, I wanted a four-wheel drive truck and I wanted world peace. I figured if I used up one of my wishes already, I'd give up world peace because

somebody else should ask for that. In an instant, Jesus came and got me and took me to heaven. It was the best

SID: I'd protest. I've never been to heaven, and all these guests go to Heaven.

LAURIE: I did. In an instant, I knew that the man Jesus Christ was alive. He was standing there, He was made out of light. He wanted me to see Him for who He really is. He turned the volume up so fantastically. It was like a dimmer switch that just was so bright. It was as if it was stronger than you were looking in the sun and I had to close my eyes.

LAURIE: Jesus turn the volume and Himself down so that we could behold him. I believe now that we can only behold Him to the degree that we love and obey Him.

SID: You know, you saw Jesus dancing with someone. Tell me that story.

LAURIE: Yes. The Lord had me look inside Him. He wanted me to give Him something and I was concerned about giving Him the pain, I didn't know how. So, I kept telling Him, no. People say you can't say no to Jesus, but we say no to Jesus all the time. He's so patient. He turned into ... There's no way to explain it, it was as if I was watching a movie inside of Him, and that movie was Jesus dancing with this beautiful bride. He was doing a very specific dance with her. While she would turn, I would notice the fire in His eyes. He has such beautiful fire for the one that He loves. And then the darkness would try and sneak up and touch this girl's dress. As it would sneak up, His eyes turned into this fire. You don't mess with his bride.

LAURIE: As she turned and danced, I ached inside. I've never been loved like that. I knew that if I could have that one thing my life would be complete. If somebody would love me like that. Not just somebody, but this God who's fantastic. When I looked at her feet, I realized those were my ankles. I have very pretty ankles.

SID: You were envious of Him loving her and that was you.

LAURIE: It was me. It was me.

SID: He wanted you to give something up.

LAURIE: Yeah. He kept asking me for something and eventually he asked me and I realized I can trust this man. When I gave the pain to Jesus, He put his forehead to my forehead. I asked Him, "Is there anything I can do for you?" He said, "Go tell others about me." What happened when I came out of the vision was, I was set free. I used to smoke three and a half packs of cigarettes a day, I did not need the medication that I was on, the depression medication I was on anymore. He actually changed who I am. I didn't used to be like this. I am supercharged now.

SID: Now, in 2008 God took you to hell, and here's the sad thing. She saw some of her relatives there. She saw many Christians there. I know that's hard to believe, but you'll understand when we come back. I know you will.

SID: You're at a conference in prayer and 2008 at IHOP. You're in a prayer there and suddenly did you ... When did you realize you were in hell? Tell me what happened.

LAURIE: We were in evangelism meeting. I was worshiping in the back with my eyes closed. And then as soon as the heat came in the room, I watched, I opened my eyes. I knew something was happening. I opened my eyes, the front of the room opened like this, Sid, and hell was right there. And an arm without fingers came flying out of hell, and it grabbed ahold of my spirit and it sucked me in. Those held doors are thick, and they're heavy, and when they slam shut, I knew exactly where I was immediately.

LAURIE: Three things were spoken over me. You are in hell eternally for unforgiveness. The worst regret you can ever imagine was right then, because there's no way out. I knew that, there was no way out of hell.

SID: Tell our audience what you observed.

LAURIE: First, I want to say there's no way that I will ever be guilty of exaggerating hell. There are not enough—

SID: Why would you not exaggerate?

LAURIE: It's worse than any words that I can come up with. When I got there, just the heat, the extreme heat started causing my skin to drip off of me. The sound of the people screaming broke my eardrums and caused such a pain inside of me and I knew this was going to go on eternally. There was no way out of it. My bones, my body twisted in so many ways, breaking. I felt my back break.

SID: Did you feel pain in hell?

LAURIE: Excruciating pain. There is not one drop of relief, there's not a drop of water, there's not a drop of light. You can never get to another human being to share that pain. You actually become sin. You start looking like this growth. You actually lose the formation of a human being because I'm made in the image of God and that changed there. It's horrific. It's horrific. I never want to go back.

LAURIE: Imagine trying to live your life with no God. I was never going to touch my grand baby's face again. Even arguing with my husband, not that that's cool, but you were never going to get to do any of that. You were never going to get to say you were sorry, you were never going to fix anything. To always be in pain and to know that it kept ramping up and it was going

to keep getting worse and worse and worse. That was never going to end. That was the thing. It wasn't like you could reach a pinnacle.

LAURIE: In hell, it worked the same as in heaven, my full brain operated, and I knew all of Matthew 18, I knew every scripture that I'd ever read, and I'd read the whole Bible. I knew every scripture that I've ever read and it made complete sense and it was completely righteous that I was in hell, and I became hate. I hated and I continued to hate. There were people there. They were just like me, they believed Jesus is the Lord God, but they refused to obey Him. They say, "We love you, we love you." But the Scriptures teach, if you love me, then obey me, and I wouldn't. And I wouldn't forgive.

LAURIE: It was the worst thing to know that in heaven Jesus had been so patient and He was willing to forgive me everything, everything, and I couldn't forgive small offenses? In my life, it felt like these things had broken me. But in reality, to everything that the Lord had forgiven me of, Sid, they were small.

SID: How did you get out of hell?

LAURIE: As quickly as I went into hell, these doors opened, and something brought me out so fast. I reentered the room, I was screaming. My friend who was running the meeting, he came to the back because I was so disruptive. He started shaking me.

SID: This was at the IHOP?

LAURIE: Yeah, he's here. My good friend, [inaudible 00:13:59] he was there and he was shaking me, asking me, "What's wrong, what's wrong, what's wrong?" And I said to him, "I've been to hell." Everything changed in that minute. As transforming as it was to go to heaven and meet Jesus Christ, that transformation does not compare to the transformation of having been to hell.

SID: When we come back, I'm going to have her share the biggest lies that Christians believe that will cause them to not make heaven. Be right back.

We'll be right back to It's Supernatural.
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We now return to It's Supernatural.

SID: She was so traumatized, understandably so that she's weeping even as she tells this story. But what did Jesus tell you as to why He took you to hell?

LAURIE: When the Lord spoke to me and finally healed my heart, He said, "I took you to hell, because I love you." If God had not shown that to me, if I had died without Him showing that to me, I know I'd be there right now. He loves me and He's mighty to say it, and in that instance, that's what it took.

SID: What do you believe is the biggest lie of the devil out there?

LAURIE: I think, once saved, always saved. It's understanding as I bump into people, I think that is a hell conspiracy. I think it's the biggest lie. Because the idea behind that, Sid, is that I'm going to give my life to Jesus today, he'll wipe away all my past sins, and it doesn't matter how I live anymore, I can—

SID: But that's the new revelation of grace, not the biblical revelation.

LAURIE: Correct.

SID: What about something like the major Christian sin that I see, that I've participated in, gossip.

LAURIE: It grieves Jesus, it should grieve us. Inside of gossip, why are we doing that first? Until you heal that you will constantly do that. Really, you need to go to Jesus and get your identity first. Then, inside of gossip, you have just murdered a person's reputation. This is very, very serious. For myself, I've made a salt covenant with my tongue with the Holy Spirit, because that is one of the first sins that I was guilty of. We think, well, it doesn't matter. Of course, every sin matters, it's recorded.

SID: When you go to bed, you do something, tell me about that.

LAURIE: I do. Before I go to sleep, I talk to Jesus and I tell Him how much I love Him, and I ask Him, "Lord, how did I do today?" Sometimes, He's like, "Laurie, you do this and you need to go fix it." And other times He tells me, "You did this and I don't want you to do that anymore." He uses it as a learning because there's a difference between immaturity and rebellion. When I'm rebellious, he needs me to fix it. If I'm just immature, He just trains me in a new way of doing things.

SID: Do you, and can I have assurance of salvation?

LAURIE: Absolutely. The blood of Jesus Christ saves us. Absolutely, exclamation mark. As a born again believer, we obey Jesus.

SID: I've always lived my life. I repent so wide. I find that if I'll do it instantly, rapidly, it's easier than if I let it get infected in me.

LAURIE: Right. Well, and I try and teach repentance in four parts; one, agree with God that what you're doing is a sin. Two, have Godly sorrow over that sin. It's more than just being sorry. Sorry, you'll do it again. Godly sorrow hurts you. Three, you confess your sin, one to another, and the Bible says, you'll be fervently healed. And step number four, you have to put something in place in your life that you will never do that again. I teach that and I help people figure out what number four do you need so that you don't sin against God again.

LAURIE: Sometimes we have to put a few number fours there, and God completes that work for us because He loves us so much. But repentance is the only acceptable sacrifice for my sin.

SID: Would you lead us in prayer for repentance?

LAURIE: Oh, Jesus, I love you. I love you, Father, I love you Holy Spirit. Thank you that you came to pay the ultimate price. You say we're worth it. Oh worthy, worthy, worthy Jesus are you. We come asking, God make us holy. Give us a hunger and a desire for holiness. God, come right now and convict us of our sin that we need to be free. We need to be set free from the ways of the devil. And God if the hell conspiracy is in any of us, Jesus, set us free. Every sin that I commit needs to be brought to you repented of. God, make me holy, and with that holiness comes more of your presence.

LAURIE: Let me rest in the assurance. You said to be holy, as your Father in Heaven is holy, I desire that, we want that, God. Would you come and rest that, wrap that around us and make us fully yours. We don't want any part hiding. Every part of us that is dark, Lord, shine your light. We love you. We love you, Jesus. In your name, we believe you're changing us. Hallelujah. Amen.

SID: If you have anything against anyone, it's not an emotion, it's a choice. It's not a process, it's a choice. I'm going to follow God or not. Yes or no. You release that person, you say, "Hell is not going to be worth my own forgiveness to you."

SID: I'll tell you something else, forgiveness doesn't mean you trust someone that's done something wrong to you. They have to earn their trust again if they want to, but it means that I am not touching that cancer. I am not touching that stuff. I don't want to touch it because that's separating me from God. God, I don't want anything separating me from you.

LAURIE: Amen.

SID: When we go off the air, you choose to forgive the people that don't deserve forgiveness. Because what did Jesus say about his coming back?

LAURIE: He told me recently, I'm coming back much sooner than you realize.

SID: Did you get that? I'm coming back sooner than you realize.

LAURIE: Hell is worse than anything that I can give you words for. Even Jesus told us that there would be weeping and gnashing of teeth and God doesn't want us there.
