SID: I'll tell you, I'm here with Becca Greenwood, and she is another person that provokes me to jealousy. Since she was a child, she was activated in a gift called discernment. So Becca, for starters, what is biblical discernment?

BECCA: That's a great question. And the reality is, discernment is something, it's a gift that is given to us by the Holy Spirit. And so when we receive the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, this gift of discernment is awakened. So it's the ability, Sid. We can know the angelic realm. We can know the demonic realm. So we know what's occurring in the spirit realm.

It gives us wisdom. It gives us the ability to understand times and seasons. It causes us to see and hear from the father's heart and his perspective. So discernment can manifest in different ways. It can be we can see something, we can hear in the spirit, we can even feel. Some people smell. Some people have what I call this knower. It's like this prophetic knower, this discernment knower that God has given us.

SID: What about someone says, "This is a woman that was born with this gift. I don't have the gift, although I believe in Jesus and I love him." What would you say to that person?

BECCA: I believe that the Holy Spirit gives this gift to each believer, and that many of us are walking in it. And listen, let's be real. Sometimes we have not because we ask not. So we can even say, "Holy spirit, begin to awaken this gift of discernment in me. Show me how you are using discernment in my life." So this is what I tell people; pray and ask and pay attention.

SID: So you mentioned that many of us have this, and shrug it off—

BECCA: We shrug it off.

SID: Rather than develop it.

BECCA: Rather than development and mature it, because one reason is the gift hasn't been taught, and another reason is we think, "Oh, that was just me. That wasn't God trying to get my attention." We begin to ignore it. Here is a scenario that happens a lot in our family. My daughters and I all have this gift of discernment. And so there are times we will go out together as a family and either myself or my daughters would say, "Do you sense that? Are you hearing that? Do you feel that? Do you see that?"

And there was one time, Sid, we were going to go to a movie, and I had just been preaching in this nation. And when I was preaching in this nation and we had to be really careful about what

we are saying. And so we go to this movie theater and Greg, my husband, looked at me and he could tell I was discerning. He goes, "Are you okay?"

I said, "Listen. I just preached in a communist nation, but I feel more danger in the atmosphere here than I did there." I never felt unsafe in that nation. And my daughters chimed in. "Dad, we feel it too." And so he said, "Let's gather as a family and pray." And so we prayed and we sought the Lord. He said, "Lord, are we in danger to be here? Is this a warning, or are we picking up on something in the atmosphere?"

And we all heard the Lord. It was something in the spiritual atmosphere. We had peace. We watched the movie and we were able to stay and have a wonderful, fun family night. But sometimes we have that discernment and we shrug it off instead of engaging the Holy Spirit and asking him what is occurring.

SID: People actually get deliverance from oppressive, evil spirits.

BECCA: Yes they do.

SID: Tell me about one.

BECCA: There was one time there was this lady, and she had been in great torment for 24 hours. It was a Sunday night at church. It was my night off. I was enjoying the glory. And one of the pastors came in and said... He came to me, tapped me on the shoulder, said, "Becca, we need your help." And so I went to the back room and here's this woman. Sid, she was in torment, just shaking. And I said, "What happened?"

She goes, "This just happened in the middle of the night. I just woke up like this." Now I had done enough deliverance ministry to know... I wasn't buying that. So I asked the Holy Spirit, Lord what happened? And he said, "Becca, ask her these exact questions in the order that I give them to you." So I said, "You were asleep at night?" And she said yes. And I said, "And it was 3:00 AM?" And she said yes. And I said, "And your children were asleep?" Yes. "And your husband is out of town on business?"

The Holy Spirit is giving me these questions and I'm repeating them. And she said yes. And I said, "And all of a sudden you're awake at 3:00, in fear." She said yes. And the Lord took me in a vision. And in that vision, I saw her get up out of bed and I watch her walk to the computer, and I watched her go to a website that she shouldn't have gone to. And so I looked at her very gently and I said, "Well, can you tell me what website you went to when you got out of bed at 3:00 AM?" And she began to sob. And she said, "I am so sorry."

And she just instantly began to repent. This woman had been trapped in sin of pornography. And in that moment, from that discernment, from hearing the Lord, feeling that red flag in my spirit saying, "Lord, give me what she needs for freedom," she instantly repented, renounced that sin, was radically set free, filled with the glory of the Lord, and has never looked back. So what if I had just pushed away what I would call that knower in my spirit, of that red flag, that caused me to say, "There's something more that is going on here."

SID: But it's all of our senses we get these nudges in. For instance, I'll be talking in front of a group and my eyes will lock onto someone that is a nudge by the Holy Spirit. But for years, I ignored it.

BECCA: Right? And so what I tell people, engage the Holy Spirit, ask the Holy Spirit. He is a gift to us, to help us and to guide us. And when we learn to pay attention to those nudges, when we learn when he is starting to speak to us, those prompts, and we dialogue with him, he will then give us the answers and solutions for victory.

SID: I'm glad God has had you put together resources so that everyone, every believer, it's God's will, that you operate this way. Now, when we return, Becca will tell about the man in the airport, that was returning from having studied in Tibet under a top Buddhist priest, and how discernment penetrated the darkness. SID: Becca, you teach, and it's so practical and really works effectively, how to develop your discernment. And one of the strong things you teach is how to intentionally cultivate an atmosphere for revelation.

BECCA: Absolutely. Sid, this sounds really basic, but there's something I'm very passionate about. When we are cultivating an atmosphere for discernment, we are ones that are spending time in the presence of the Lord and the Holy Spirit. A word that I will even use is intentional surrender, meaning that we worship him. We glorify him. We come before him and we cease resistance. We yield to him and we begin to cultivate an atmosphere where we hear his voice, we know his voice, we're reading the word and we say, "Holy spirit, let your word come alive in me." Kathryn Kuhlman had this awesome quote that I love. It isn't silver vessels that he's asking for. It isn't golden vessels that he needs. He just needs yielded vessels.

SID: And one of the greatest ministries that I have personally ever witnessed, was a woman that says, "I was God's last choice." And that means, it doesn't matter what you have to give. It matters whether you want to intentionally yield to God. Okay. Tell me about this guy that studied under a top Buddhist priest in Tibet.

BECCA: Absolutely. So here we are, right? We're in the airport. I'm traveling home, been teaching on deliverance all weekend in prophecy. In the airport, Sid, there's no personal bubble at the restaurants. People are like this close to you. And you don't know them. So we're sitting at the booth and we're about to order our food. And this young gentleman gets set right next to me. Now I'm a discerner. I see and I feel, and I hear in the spirit.

So I felt this vibration. And I'm just going to say it, it was a demonic, a cult, witchcraft vibration coming from him in the spirit. So I looked over the menu at my friend who also discerns, and we're kind of making eye contact like... And so we order our food, he orders his, and I feel him looking at me. So I turn and I smile and I said hello. And he said, "Oh, can I ask who you meditate to?" I said, "Well, you can."

And he said, "Who is it?" I said, "It's Jesus of Nazareth." And he said, "Oh, I just returned from Tibet. I was with the top Tibetan Buddhist priest. And he taught me how to meditate. And Jesus was one of my spirit guides that came to me when I was meditating." He said, "Can you tell me? I feel warmth. I see peace and joy. And this countenance, this light around you, do I have that on me?" And I thought, perfect setup from the Lord. And I said, "Can I be really honest with you?" And he said yes. And I said, "Now, I'm meaning this in love," but I said, "Not really. Can I show you what I feel from you?"

And he said yes. And so I said, "This is kind of what it feels like." And I started trembling and making that sound of that vibration. And he looked at me shocked. He goes, "Why don't I have what you have?" I said, "Because it wasn't Jesus that came to you. It was an angel of darkness appearing as an angel of light."

SID: How does he react?

BECCA: He said, "I want what you have. Will you lay hands on me?"

SID: Really?

BECCA: Yes. So here we are in the restaurant, in the airport, lay hands on him. And I began to pray. And he looked at me and he said, "My mother has been telling me what I'm doing is wrong. And she's a Christian. She's been praying for a divine appointment for me. You're that divine appointment."

SID: He knew that.

BECCA: He knew that, and he instantly felt the presence of the Lord. I said, "Do you feel and know the difference?" And he said yes. And he said right then, "Lord, I surrender my life back to you." And he looked at me and he said, "I will begin going to church with my mom again on this Sunday."

SID: Tell me about how the Issachar anointing operates with discernment. First of all, explain who Issachar was.

BECCA: Issachar was born... Was Leah's son and from Jacob. And it's interesting, Sid. The time he was born was very prophetic because it was during the wheat harvest, which is also the same time at Pentecost. And so his name means one that is blessed, that is a gift. And so Issachar became one of the leaders of what we call the sons of Issachar. The tribes of Issachar. And he grew in favor and discernment.

It says in the Bible that the sons of Issachar understood the times and the seasons and the way Israel should go. And so people are saying, "Well, that's the sons of Issachar." You know what I find interesting? When all the tribes gathered together with David and this should give us great hope, every one of you listen, because when they gathered for David to become King, they had to bring thousands from the other tribes. But 200 of the sons of Issachar could accomplish what it took thousands from the other tribes because of the discernment and wisdom.

So what is it? The sons of Issachar? You say these were men that God anointed in the Bible, but the reality is he's called each of us as a son and a daughter to have the anointing, to understand the times and the seasons that we're living in, the times and the seasons that we're in as a family, the times and the seasons that we are in personally. The sons of Issachar knew when it was time to harvest. We have all been prophesying. We are in the greatest time of harvest.

SID: You know what, as things get darker in the world, those that have the sons of Issachar anointing are going to shine and they're not going to be afraid.

BECCA: They're not going to be afraid—

SID: Of anything. It's time that your discernment wakes up. Becca, we'll pray that Issachar anointing when we return.

SID: Becca, give us some practical tips on how to discern in our everyday life, at home with family, with work, with job, whatever, at an airport.

BECCA: Yes. At an airport. Sid, we already talked about earlier, right? We've cultivated. We've intentionally cultivated that relationship with the Holy Spirit. So what we have to understand is he is with us 24 hours a day, seven days a week. He's not an it. He's a person, right? So when we encounter him, that presence is rubbed on us like anointing oil, that charisma, then anointing. And so we take it with us.

And so in everyday life, you begin to look like what we talked about. What are those prompts? Are there those nudges of the Holy Spirit that he's asking you to do? So it could be when you are in your work place, all of a sudden someone is walking by and you just feel the intent or you feel or hear or see that person and your eyes are drawn to them. As we said, stop and engage the Holy spirit and ask, "Lord, what is it that you're saying?"

Listen, even in our homes, people ask me this a lot. How can we discern? Even in our homes, we want to have an atmosphere of worship and welcoming the presence of the Lord into our homes. And when we do that, listen, we can discern our children. We can discern what's happening with our spouses, and we can take that and we can begin to pray. We can begin to encourage them.

SID: And then by the way, if you don't have this inside information, No wonder you have problems. Wouldn't you like to work on inside information about your spouse before the explosion?

BECCA: That's right.

SID: By the way, what do you discern right now?

BECCA: What do I discern right now? That's a great question. I discern right now, Sid, we're seeing so much chaos in our world right now. The enemy, there is a battle that is raging in the world right now. But this chaos and confusion that we're seeing, Sid, is not so we are defeated. Literally what I am discerning, and I want you all to hear this because I'm going to apply this to you personally as well, what I am discerning as we are entering into the greatest glory, the greater glory than we've ever experienced before.

And so for each of you that are listening, no matter what we are seeing... I shared this scripture, when I was teaching on the CDs, it says arise, shine, Isaiah 64, your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. Even though there's darkness covering the earth, the glory will be seen on you and will increase on you.

SID: Do you believe that it'll be seen on people?

BECCA: I believe it'll be seen on people. Think about Moses.

SID: Right. He had to put a veil.

BECCA: When he had to put a veil. But the word of God promises us. We with unveiled faces will radiate. Even when I was sharing about this young man in the airport, that light that he saw in me was God's glory. I want you all to hear right now that even what I'm discerning right now, even over the next three months, as we see things unfold and there's increased chaos, keep your perspective on him.

See from the Father's perspective, from heaven down, when you encounter him, and let that glory increase in you, because this is the finest hour of Christianity, Sid, that the world has seen. And listen, we have to have kingdom discernment. You have to have kingdom discernment because I'm going to be real honest. If we listen to the media, if we listen to the voices of the world that are trying to promote fear, then we will succumb to that fear. We are not ones who are to have a spirit of fear. God is awakening glory in each of us in this season that we will be the ones in victory. We will be the ones with the solution.

SID: Becca, I'm going to have you pray a second for the Issachar anointing. I want you to know that you either know God or you don't. Has nothing to do with church attendance. Has nothing to do with what you've been taught. And just to make sure, so you receive all the Issachar anointing, I want you to say this prayer with me out loud, right where you are. Dear God, I am a sinner. I'm so sorry. I believe the blood of Jesus has washed away my sins, and I am clean. And

now that I am clean, I ask Jesus to come and live inside of me. Jesus, be my lord and savior.
Becca, pray.

BECCA: Yes. Lord, I release right now the boldness to be a demon tormentor. Lord, I release right now, the discernment to see and hear in the angelic realm, that they will know that they know that there are more for them than against them. And they will understand, as the sons of Issachar did, harvest, how to lead, how to be a solutionist, how to walk in victory, and how to have discernment, Lord, even for the appointed time of their destiny that you have called them into. In Jesus' name. Amen.
