SID: Why does God say in Zechariah 2:8 in the Living Bible, "He who harms you," that's Israel, "sticks their finger in Jehovah's eye?" Why is the nation of Israel so important? Why is tiny Israel on the front page of every newspaper in the world frequently? What country was Jesus born in? What country did Jesus demonstrate his kingdom in? What country did he die, buried, and resurrected in? What country will he return to? What country will he rule for a thousand years? Israel. Israel is a miracle in many ways. The fact that it just exists today is a miracle.

SID: The fact that there are Jewish people today is a miracle. Let me explain why. Israel was conquered in 70 AD. The temple was destroyed. We Jews that survived this attack were scattered to the four corners of the earth. Wherever we went, we were persecuted. Everything I'm telling you was prophesied by the Jewish prophets in the Jewish scriptures in advance. There should be no physical Jews today. None, but God. Jeremiah 31:35-36 says, "As long as there's a sun, moon and stars, there will be a physical Jew on the face of this earth."

SID: So against all odds, one of the greatest miracles the world has ever seen, they're not even aware of, that we Jewish people exist as a distinct people today. In Romans the 11th chapter verse 28 and 29, "From the point of view of God's choice of election, of design selection, they, that's the Jewish people, are still the beloved dear people of God for the sake of their forefathers. That's why for the promises to the forefathers, for God's gifts and his call are irrevocable. And he does not change his mind."

SID: Against all odds, the Jewish people still exist as a distinct people group. But not just the Jewish people, it's even more. It's also the land of Israel. Why? Who owns the land of Israel? Did you know there's an owner? It's not the Jewish people. Did you know that? Did you know there's an owner? It's not the Arabs. Did you know that there is an owner? Leviticus 25:23 says, God is speaking, "The land is mine." But then if you own property, do you have a right to lease it, to rent it? Of course, you do. And Psalm 105 is the lease agreement between God and the Jewish people.

SID: That terms, if I was an attorney, I'd like to argue in a court room, here are the terms from God himself. God says he remembers his covenant forever. How long? Forever. Just in case she didn't get that, then he goes on to say he commanded it to a thousand generations. What we got? Forever, a thousand generations. And then just in case you missed it, everlasting. Not only do we have a lease from God himself whose terms are forever, but we also know the exact size of Israel.

SID: At a time when the world is trying to shrink Israel, God says the land of Israel, as we see it right now, should be at least, and I'm being conservative, 10 times larger. It's exactly found in

Genesis 15:18-21. That begs the question, why are these promises about the Jews in Israel so important? God tells us the answer. They are important to you, to me, to God.

SID: Matthew 23:39 says why these promises are so important, "For I say to you, this is Jesus speaking, I say to you, you shall have seen me no more until you, that's the Jewish people, say

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"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." Why is it so important to God? It's the return of Jesus. Is that important to God, to me, to you? Why is this so important to the devil? Because he doesn't want to see the return of Jesus. That's the end of him. He's curtains. Again, begs the question, what is the purpose of God?

SID: Preserving the Jew. You ask 10 Christians this question, most won't be able to answer it. Do you know what the purpose of preserving the Jew is? Let me read this to you. That they, this is John 17:21. Who's they? There were only two people groups at that time, Jew and Gentile also may be one. What will happen when Jew and Gentile are one in Messiah? That the world will believe. If you say, "Think that's important that the world..." In other words, the body is incomplete without the Jewish believers in Jesus.

SID: The body is incomplete without the Gentile believers in Jesus. The body of Messiah is incomplete without the two people groups that he died for and loves becoming one, not just one in fellowship, but one and to him. And then it's going to be that devil's worst nightmare. In fact, there's no other nation in the world that God makes this promise about. Let me read this to you. In Psalm 122:6, "Pray for the peace." Do you know the Hebrew word for it peace? Shalom. Do you know what one of the meanings of shalom is? Completeness.

SID: Pray for the completeness of Jerusalem. Do you know what the completeness of Jerusalem, of Israel is? Jew and Gentile one in Messiah. When you pray for the peace, the completeness of Jerusalem, the one new man that Paul marvels about in the Book of Ephesians, you will... This is what God says. They will prosper who love Jerusalem. Do you know how a great Hebrew scholar by the name of Derek Prince, who's in heaven now, defined the word in Hebrew *prosper*? And he said the word prosper in Hebrew means heart peace.

SID: Heart peace. Pray for the completeness of Jerusalem. Thou shall have heart peace that love thee. Anyone you know need some heart peace? Now, this is a biblical fact. The glory of the Jews will usher in the greatest revival, the greatest harvest of souls in history. Be right back.

There's a job description in the Bible. Did you know that? For the Jewish believer. Do you know what our job description is? Evangelize the Gentile.

SID: John 4:22 says, "Salvation is from the Jews." In the last days, we know about the 144,000 from the Book of Revelation. Well, everyone knows about that. But in the last days, the Jewish people will be super evangelists, just like Paul. In Zachariah 8:23, it says, "Thus, says the Lord of hosts, in those days, that's the last days, 10 men from every language of the nations, where nations means Gentiles, it says, will grab hold of the garment, that's the tallit or the prayer shawl, of a Jew saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard faith comes from hearing.

SID: We have heard that God is with you." That's the job of the Jewish believer. So what's the job of the Gentile believer? Even higher. Let me tell you about it. Romans 11:11 tells you what your job is. It's good to know what your job description is in the Bible. Wouldn't you say? I say then, have they, that's the Jewish people, stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not, but through their fall to provoke them, to provoke the Jewish people, to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles.

SID: Well, we might say the job of the Gentile believer is to walk in such the amount of fullness of God's spirit and his glory and his presence, that it provokes Jewish people the jealousy. We need each other. Why? So the world will believe. God teaches all Israel will be saved when Jesus returns. But what happens to your Jewish or Gentile friends if they before knowing Jesus? I'll tell you what happens. They die in their sins separated from God forever. Listen to these two scriptures, Ezekiel 18:4. It's absolute. The soul who sins shall die.

SID: Psalm 143:2, in your sight, in God's sight, no one living is righteous. And here's the most amazing thing. In the year 70 AD, the temple was destroyed. Well, no temple, no sacrifice. So in 70 AD, we stopped having sacrifices. No Yom Kippur, the only way of Jew can have our sins covered, because there's not one righteous. If we sin one sin, when you die, that means cut off from God forever. So what do we Jews do? Well, a famous Messianic Jew by the name of John had the answer. He was talking about Passover. Remember what happened at Passover with my Jewish people?

SID: We sacrificed a lamb and put the blood on the doorpost and the angel of death could not come into our home. When John saw the Messiah, he said in John 1:29, "Look, the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." Well, our rabbis are very inventive. Our rabbis reinvented Judaism. But the Torah says without the shedding of blood, there is no atonement for sin? And the Talmud says you can't even celebrate Yom Kippur without the shedding of blood. Now here's what most Christians don't know, we are at what the Bible calls the fullness of the Gentile age.

SID: Now, why do I say this? Because the Bible has two reasons why. Number one, why we're at the fullness of the Gentile age, it's important for us all to know, Luke 21:24, Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles, in other words, be a non-Jewish possession, until the times at the Gentiles are fulfilled. Another miracle. In one day, Jerusalem in 1967 for the first time since Jesus uttered

that announcement and the temple was destroyed, so since 70 AD, we have not Jerusalem in Jewish possession.

SID: But in 1967, God had a miracle war and Jerusalem was in Jewish hands for the first time since the temple was destroyed. What does that mean? It means that in time, prophetic time clock started ticking again. But not the hours, the minutes. Romans 11:25, the second reason we're in the fullness of the Gentile age, "For I do not desire brethren that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion.

SID: Blindness in part, in part because there are some Jewish people that believe in Jesus now, like myself, blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in." In other words, when you see the blindness coming off of the eyes of Jewish people, remember Saul of Tarsus was blinded and he couldn't see, but when the scales came off, he saw Jesus. In the last few years, I have personally found that blindness on the scales of Jewish people in reference to Jesus has come off.

SID: In the last few years, I've done what are called lectures on the supernatural to Jewish population centers in Ukraine, in Russia, and in Israel. 13,500 Jewish people have made professions of faith in the last few years, mostly in Israel. Do you know why? The Jew requires a sign, a miracle? That's what Bible tells us, the Jew requires a sign. And when the glory of God shows up, signs and wonders occur. The glory of God is the difference maker. So it begs the question, who brought the glory first? Romans 9:4 answers this.

SID: To the Jew belongs for glory. That's the Shekinah, the glory of God that followed the cloud in the pillar of fire that followed the Jewish people for 40 years in the wilderness. Now that's the Old Testament, Sid. What about the New Testament? Who received the glory first in the New Testament? Do you remember Pentecost? It's really the Jewish feast of Shavuot. Who got the glory first? The Jews.

SID: Now you might be able to understand Mark 10:31, but many who are first, who were the first to receive the good news, the first to receive the glory, the Jews, will be last to receive the good news and receive the glory. And the last, that's the Jewish people, will be first to bring the gospel to the world in the latter days, as we were first to bring the gospel. And the job as the Gentile believer is to be an older brother to the Jewish people, because we know nothing of the Bible. The Jewish people started what is going on....

SID: Salvation is of the Jew and you will see the Jews end what is going on. The greater glory ushers in the greatest harvest in history. Haggai 2:9 says, "The latter glory of the house shall be greater than the former, says the Lord of hosts. And in this place, I will give peace in the glory. I will give completeness." The greater glory has started. So when will the harvest start? Bible tells us exactly when the worldwide harvest is going to start.

SID: Amos 9:13-14, "That time will come, says the Lord, when the grain and grapes will grow faster than they can be harvested. I will bring, and this is the timing, when I bring my exiled people of Israel back from distant lands, they will rebuild their ruined cities and they will live in them again."
