Sid Roth: Holy Spirit, you're our most important guest. Thank you. Thank you. Thank you that you're already here. Thank you. This is your platform. Take over. Rabbi Felix Halpern has an amazing Jewish legacy from his parents. Felix, tell us about that. I think it's terrific.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: My journey to my Judaism was pretty much like the Lord took the Israelites to the promised land the long way, and it began, of course it comes from one side is Orthodox Judaism, but the other side is rooted in Nazi resistance. My father was raised in an Orthodox Jewish home. My grandfather was an Orthodox rabbi in Germany. My father was the only one that escaped. The rest were killed, went to the camps, and were killed.

And my father made it through the transport that the nations, the UK and different nations, were transporting Jewish children out of Germany into Europe. And my father went into the Dutch underground to be hidden there in safety. Just happened to be my maternal grandparents who were resistance fighters, who were underground leaders in fighting the resistance of the Nazis. And so in that time my father saw the sacrifices of the Dutch Christians and that had such a tremendous impact on him that brought him to the decision to receive Yeshua. However, at that particular time, there was no understanding like we have today, number one of Messianic Judaism. It was in its infant stages. Many people believed like there are replacement theology and different things that a Jewish person when they received Jesus, Yeshua, is no longer Jewish. And that's what he was indoctrinated into.

Sid Roth: And that's what you were indoctrinated into.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I was indoctrinated into that. He did everything he could to hide his Judaism too.

Sid Roth: You were raised Christian yet there was something lacking. In 1970 you're driving your car and you call out to God. What happened?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I was working one morning and I was going out on the road and I had reached my ultimate desperation. I had met my beautiful wife. She was strongly rooted in Judaism. The conflict began to emerge. It was love at first sight. We met and six months later we were married and we've been married now for 47 years. But I was beginning to be stirred by that. And I remember there's a place in New Jersey called the Ramapo Reservation and I pulled over into the car and I cried out to the Lord and I asked Yeshua Jesus to come into my life and to make my life whole. And when I opened my eyes, there was like a curtain, like this set, a curtain drew and I saw light and I saw everything different. I went home that day and my wife immediately knew the difference. I was no longer this religious rigid guy. It was a problem. I was raised religious and there's a rigidity to a religious spirit.

Sid Roth: Did you feel anything or see anything when this presence came?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I felt the power of God. I felt the power of Yeshua enter my life. I felt the spirit of God in my car. That curtain drew and life was different. There was a different scenery before me and I went home that day and because my whole character changed and my wife knew, "Whoa. Something's changed." She no longer was seeing this guy who through religious eyes, rather fanatical, quite frankly, I was. It was unrelenting. It was really bad and God just changed everything. And I loved her for who she was. I became a totally different person. Six months later, she had received the Lord because she saw the absolute transformation in my life.

Sid Roth: Not only did she receive the Lord, but you had to unlearn what is called replacement theology that the Jew or Israel has been replaced by the church. Well, God doesn't change. So I'll give you one guess who made the changing. But the truth of the matter is that as life went on in 2019, he went to the doctor and there was a medical mistake and he died. Now I've never died and most of us have never died. I want to know what that dying process was like. You saw an angel. What happened?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: The process to death was terrible. My body was filled within a toxic storm from a misdiagnosis. I consumed seven and a half months of medication in 29 days. The doctor misdiagnosed me and quite frankly when I came back and I really wanted to share my story with everyone, I called the pharmacy and the pharmacy immediately changed my medical records because they wanted to make it look like they didn't make an error. Right? But the journey to death was painful. That one Friday night, it was the whole month, a culmination of that month, I was in absolute pain. My body was on fire. I say this all the time because I have to say it because my wife has finally forgiven me for not telling her.

I never wanted her to worry. I just didn't want her to worry. And that night, Friday night, I'm in terrible pain. I didn't wake my wife up. I'm going downstairs to lay on the couch and I said, "If the pain is still there, if it has not relented at all, I'm going to tell her to call 911. I'm going to the hospital." But it didn't happen. I went down to lay down. And, you know, I get emotional when I share that point because I still live the moment of the tearing of the body, the feeling of the chest caving in, the moment that life, that mortal life ends, that split second. So that's a bump for me. I have to get over that one. So it happened and my spirit just left my body. My spirit actually, it stepped out of my body like I'm getting up from a night's sleep, just stepped out.

Sid Roth: What about all the pain you had?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: Gone. Everything was gone. I rose to the top of the living room where I was. My body was lying in the spiritual realm, lying on a horizontal position. There was an angel there that was waiting for me. But as I'm in the spiritual realm, I'm looking down at my body lying lifeless on the couch, I saw instantly in a moment of time prophetically my wife and children around the kitchen table planning my funeral in absolute sorrow and devastation. And it was in that split second, I felt a heaviness, but the angel was there over my body that it was a strangest feeling that has taken me some time to understand the purpose of why I do what I do today now, the message.

Sid Roth: Let me take you to heaven because I'm told it's a no time zone. That's why when God sees something that's going to happen and his prophets recorded in the Bible or say it, there's no guesswork. He's seen it already happen. What's it like to live in a no time zone?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: It impacted me when I came back to such a--I'll go back to that, that ever since I no longer wear a watch, I wear a compass on my wrist.

Sid Roth: How do you make your appointments?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I don't care. I'm here. I care to be here on time with you. Of course. But I live in the moment. I live in a rhythm. I've learned how to tell time by the position of the sun.

Sid Roth: You really don't wear a--

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I'm strange. I know. It drives my wife crazy.

Sid Roth: You really don't wear a watch?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: No. I don't care about time. I'm untethered to this world. It doesn't matter. I've learned to follow a rhythm. The Moedim, the Jewish Feast, the whole system in the Bible is all about a rhythm of life. We go from season to season. I love it. It kind of made me uncomfortable coming here in the airport because everything is structured in time. So anyway...

Sid Roth: When you came back from heaven, you went to what's called the second heaven.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I did. I did.

Sid Roth: Where, the third heaven is where God and angels are.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: I did.

Sid Roth: Second heaven is the devil and demons.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: Yeah.

Sid Roth: And the thought that you left with had to do with the power of the blood and--

Rabbi Felix Halpern: The teaching that I came back with that has turned everything on my head. I've known the Lord for 46 years and I've been inundated with the power of the devil and demons for, believe it. And I was over the second heaven looking down into this cavern, this space, probably into the darkness of hell in the upper chambers of hell perhaps. And these demons were there and two in particular, one in particular, but there was another one was trying to crawl up out of this catacomb to grab ahold of my ankles, but it couldn't. And he kept trying and he was pitiful. And I will say that the Lord showed me these demons that were originally fallen angels, they live in a continuous progressive decay. We go as believers, we go from glory to glory and beauty to beauty. They live in absolute decay and they were horrid looking and the reason they could not touch me as much as they tried, I was covered by the blood, the blood border. The blood border, they could not touch me.

Sid Roth: I hope you got that. He recognized how much power that God has given the least believer, the least believer.

Rabbi Felix Halpern: The least.

Sid Roth: Now, Rabbi Felix, you're from Jersey, not from Texas. Why are you wearing boots?

Rabbi Felix Halpern: When I came back from the second heaven and I saw the powerlessness, the impotence of the devil and his demons, I wear these boots, these snake boots, python boots when I'm only out for assignments and spiritual reasons to remind me, not me remind people that the devil is under my feet and I happen to take the devil and make boots out of him.

Go over here. Driving down the road, go into that parking lot. You're at the store. Stop what you're doing. There's a man over there that needs prayer. There's a woman over there that needs encouragement. Every day is a day where the spirit of God is moving.

Sid Roth: What did you learn about God's sovereignty?
